

Frequently asked Questions

What is SportSafe?

SportSafe is a wholly owned subsidiary of Gymleader NZ Ltd. We are dedicated to maintaining safety standards for all sports facilities and equipment.

What is a SportSafe inspection?

SportSafe inspections are designed to ensure the safety of all sports equipment and give peace of mind to the users and facility management.

What does a SportSafe inspection cover?

Our standard inspection includes:

All fixed sports equipment such as basketball hoops, ladders, rings, ropes etc.

Wall fixings, support wires, chains, hinges, pivots and structures.

All removable sports equipment such as uneven and parallel bars, trampolines, mats, nets, posts and portable storage equipment.

How long does a SportSafe inspection take?

Generally, depending on the size of the facility, between half a day and a day for the site inspection.

The gymnasium floor will not be required for the whole time, we can usually work around your programme.

Inspection of ceiling fixings may require a lifting platform to be hired. We are happy to co-ordinate changing of light bulbs, retrieval of balls etc. with your maintenance staff.

An inspection report is generally sent within five working days of the physical inspection.

How often do I need a SportSafe inspection?

Most facilities undertake an annual inspection as part of their obligations under the *Health and Safety in Employment (HSE) Act 1992*.

If requested we can make more frequent inspections or can inspect on request.

What does a SportSafe report cover?

A list of equipment inspected.

Certificates of inspection for equipment deemed safe.

A list of repairs required for immediate safety.

A list of advised maintenance.

What is not covered in the fixed cost inspection fee?

Hire of lifting equipment if required.

Replacement, refurbishment or repair of equipment.

Re-inspection and certification of equipment not repaired by us.

Our building has a Warrant of Fitness. Why do I need a SportSafe inspection?

A building Warrant of Fitness covers only the structure of the building, not the equipment attached to it.

We already have a regular safety audit, Why do we need a SportSafe inspection?

General safety audits usually cover documentation and procedures, not a detailed physical inspection of all equipment, fixings, hinges and cables.

SportSafe do nothing but gymnasium equipment inspections - We know sports equipment, what to look for and how to get the maximum life out of your gear.

Support and winch wire should be subjected to a close visual inspection to detect any fraying, fretting or damage that may cause a sudden catastrophic failure. We physically inspect each wire and termination. All replacement cables come from certified, traceable sources.

Not only do we inspect but we adjust, do preventative maintenance and minor repairs during the inspection - saving time and money.
